


The Larry Steckline Agricultural Appreciation Endowed Scholarship



This renewable scholarship was established by Larry and Carla Steckline to demonstrate Larry's appreciation for the farmers, ranchers and others in the WaKeeney area who supported his radio and television ag-business broadcasting career. Eligible students must be a 1) a graduating senior of TCHS, Larry's alma mater, or will earn a GED by May 15 of the scholarship year and reside in the attendance area of TCHS, 2) have maintained a 3.0 grade point average, and 3) show financial need.

To be eligible for the Larry Steckline Agricultural Appreciation Endowed Scholarship, a student may fall into one of the following three categories:

- 1) A student who has had an active level of involvement in a farm, ranch, or other agricultural enterprise growing up, but who chooses to pursue a non-agricultural program of study; or
- 2) A student who has not necessarily had any active involvement in a farm, ranch, or other agricultural enterprise growing up, but who chooses to pursue an agricultural related certificate or degree; A student in this category must, in addition, continue enrollment in an agricultural related certificate or degree program; or
- 3) A student who has both had an agricultural background and also intends to pursue an agricultural related certificate or degree.

The first installment of \$500 will be sent to the financial aid office of the school the recipient will attend. The second installment will be sent after TCFFEE receives a first semester transcript showing a grade point average of at least 3.0. A transcript will be required for each additional semester showing a grade point average of at least 3.0 and if qualifying for this scholarship according to category #2 or #3 showing classes relating to an agricultural related major in order for the next semester's funds to be sent to the financial aid office.
